



## Deming Ranchettes in Luna County, NM

### Overview

Luna County is located in southern New Mexico and is characterized by open desert land, low population density, and simple rural infrastructure. The area attracts buyers who want to own land without pressure — whether as a long-term hold, a future homesite, or a property they may never actively use.

Deming Ranchettes is a rural subdivision outside the City of Deming. Parcels are typically held for years, sometimes decades, with owners choosing when to develop. There is no HOA, and county oversight remains straightforward.

Ownership here is about flexibility and control, not immediacy.

Small border town with limited services and local amenities.

  - Expanded medical facilities
  - Universities and colleges
  - Major retail and dining
  - Regional airport access

- City of Rocks State Park (hiking, camping, rock formations)
- Rockhound State Park (mineral collecting, trails, camping)
- Florida Mountains (scenic backdrop and exploration)
- Wide-open skies suitable for stargazing
